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### SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

- Complete bimonthly Site observation walk during week of July 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
- Mobilize and begin work activities associated with the drainage improvements and south washout restoration work in July 2016. Mobilization is anticipated to start on July 15<sup>th</sup> with earthwork starting July 18<sup>th</sup>. The process is expected to be complete by August 15<sup>th</sup>. The work is being conducted in accordance with a Short Term Response Action Plan (STRAP) which was approved by Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) on April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016. National Grid will have a representative on-site who will monitor the work and conduct air monitoring throughout the project. The air monitoring will be consistent with the site-specific, RIDEM-submitted Air Quality Monitoring Plan that includes a two-tiered approach during intrusive activities.
- Support work activities being performed by the City of Pawtucket associated with their Max Read Field (MRF) reconstruction project. National Grid will have a representative on-site to monitor the City's work that is planned on a small portion of the Tidewater Site. Anticipated activities include air monitoring, assistance with soil management including the planned transport of excess materials from the MRF project to the Tidewater Site by the City of Pawtucket. We understand the City plans to initiate earthwork activities at MRF in mid-July 2016.
