The following summarizes response actions completed at the Former Tidewater Facility for the period September 1 through September 30, 2019, as well as planned future activities.

SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- GZA performed bi-weekly Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.
- Beta performed a geotechnical investigation program as part of the Narragansett Bay Commission's Phase III Combined Sewer Overflow upgrade project between September 3, 2019 and September 9, 2019. GZA provided oversight of the investigation program and posted and uploaded air monitoring results to the bulletin boards and the project website.
- On September 17 and 18, 2019, Stanley Tree completed an herbicide treatment program to address the presence of an invasive plant species, specifically Japanese Knotweed, in advance of the Site remedy. Consistent with the CRMC Assent, a certified CRMC Invasive Manager monitored the treatment program.

FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
- Performance of an annual groundwater monitoring event the week of October 14, 2019.
