DEM has reviewed the sediment sampling plan dated December 5, 2007 that was submitted to DEM pursuant to paragraph (C)(4)(i) of the Consent Agreement. The sampling plan has been approved with one change: in addition to the testing parameters described in the plan, Charbert will include testing for total metals.

In accordance with paragraph (C)(4)(k) of the Agreement, Charbert must complete the sampling within **forty-five (45) days of receipt of this letter.**

In accordance with paragraph (C)(4)(l) of the Agreement, Charbert must submit a UIC Closure Application within **seventy-five (75) days of receipt of this letter.** The UIC Closure Application must include a report on the findings of the sediment sampling plan and the other documents described in paragraph (C)(4)(l).
