Per our discussions regarding carbon dioxide concentrations at the Springfield Street school, I am providing a copy of the attached table from the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers, Inc. (ASHRAE) Standard 62.1-2007 Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality. The table summarizes regulatory standards for indoor air contaminants, including carbon dioxide. Note that these standards are generally 8 hour averages, as opposed to the snapshot readings we collect during monitoring. We have been doing the monitoring later in the day after the building has been fully occupied for several hours.
