Dear Mr. Sepe and Mr. Tremblay:

The Department of Environmental Management is in receipt of the August 25, 2006 Letter Report from your consultant LFR concerning the City of Providence's repairing of the deficiencies identified in the Spring of 2006 by Attorney Stephen Fischbach. As you are aware, these deficiencies were reported the Department and the RI Superior Court during settlement negotiations concerning the Superior Court decision filed on October 3, 2005.

Based upon the information in the report, the City of Providence has not remedied the deficiencies noted to the Department's satisfaction. The City informed the Department and the Superior Court that the deficiencies were going to be immediately corrected during the summer months after school closed. The Report states that a site tour was conducted with the design team from the original facility construction on June 13, 2006, yet to date, no permanent corrective actions have been performed or a corrective action plan even submitted for review and approval. The only work that has been performed was someone placing cold asphalt patch in a few locations which in the eyes of the Department is unacceptable.

Please submit a Corrective Action plan to address all deficiencies on the site on or before **October 1, 2006**.
