The following summarizes response actions completed at the Former Tidewater Facility for the period May 1 through May 31, 2019, as well as planned future activities.

SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- GZA performed bi-weekly Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.
- On May 3, 2019, GZA performed additional utility survey work along the Seekonk River.
- Between May 8 and May 9, 2019, Moran Environmental Recovery completed test pit explorations along the riverfront to further investigate the presence of potential below grade utilities. GZA provided engineering oversight and perimeter air monitoring during the test pit work.
- On May 17, 2019, GZA surveyed additional Site features to facilitate the design of the Site remedy.
- On May 31, 2019, GZA submitted a Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP) Addendum to RIDEM.

FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
