Re: NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE DESIGNER'S LICENSE
Class II License D2046

Dear Mr. Drexel:

Pursuant to Sections 42-35-14, 5-56.1-8 and 42-17.1-2 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended, you are hereby notified that the Director of the Department of Environmental Management (the "DEM") has reasonable grounds to believe that you have violated the provisions of Rhode Island General Laws, Section 5-56.1-1 et seq and the Rules and Regulations Establishing Minimum Standards Relating to Location, Design, Construction, and Maintenance of Individual Sewage Disposal Systems (the "ISDS Regulations").

The DEM has completed a review of fifty-two (52) applications and plans prepared by you from October 1, 1999 through September 1, 2004. A list of the applications reviewed is attached to this letter.

This review has revealed a series of violations of the ISDS Regulations. These actions indicate a clear failure to comply with the requirements in the ISDS Regulations and demonstrate gross or repeated negligence, incompetence or misconduct in representation of site conditions in an application to the DEM and design of an ISDS.

Please be advised that the DEM intends to take an enforcement action against you which will result in the suspension and/or revocation of your Class II license (D2046). The Rhode Island General Laws and the ISDS Regulations affords you the opportunity to request a preliminary hearing before the DEM to show cause why the DEM should not suspend or revoke your license. If you wish to have this opportunity, you must call David Chopy at 222-4700 extension 7257 to schedule a specific date and time with the DEM within ten (10) days of your receipt of this notice.

If you fail to request a preliminary hearing or if you fail to show cause why the Director should not suspend or revoke your license, DEM will proceed with the action. The action to suspend or revoke a designer's license is subject to appeal in accordance with Section SD 25.05(h) of the ISDS Regulations
