The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

The Board reviewed the draft March 7, 2018 meeting minutes.

After brief discussion, Mr. Patenaude motioned to approve The Northern Maine's Community College: Water Treatment Technology course after confirmation of hours for the 3rd and 4th semesters, Mr. McLynch seconded. All members voted in favor to approve the course pending the confirmation of hours. All members voted in favor, as such the motion passed pending confirmation.

Mr. Schock motioned to deny the class from FirstNet Learning: Confined Space Entry as it was a requirement for employment. Mr. Desrosiers seconded the motion. All members voted in favor, as such the course was denied.
