Subject: Springfield Street School Monitoring
Jeff,

We started the Springfield Street School Monitoring for this quarter during the week of February 12. However, due to weather issues we were not able to complete all of the monitoring that week. I am returning to the site today to monitor the sub-slab ventilation system which I was not able to access last week because the locks were frozen, and we are going to attempt to sample the groundwater monitoring wells again on Monday (2/26). Three of the five groundwater monitoring wells were inaccessible due to ice that formed over the wells.

Indoor air monitoring was completed on February 15, and the soil gas monitoring has been completed. During the soil gas monitoring, we detected exceedances of the carbon dioxide action level in 25 of 29 wells. Carbon dioxide concentrations ranged from 0.1% to 4.8%.

We will submit the monitoring report after all laboratory results are received.
