- Solicitation of applications and question/answer session regarding the allocation of \$400,000 in Brownfields Assessment Grant FY 2008 funding.
  - In accordance with the grant proposal, only brownfields sites in the following seven Rhode
    Island communities are eligible Warwick, West Warwick, Cranston, Coventry, Woonsocket,
    Pawtucket and Central Falls.
- Discussion about upcoming FY 2009 Brownfields Assessment Grant funding.
  - O RI DEM expects EPA's FY 2009 competitive grant application guidelines to include new opportunities for assessment applications, called coalition assessments. An assessment coalition is a group of three or more eligible entities (states and municipalities) that submits one grant proposal under the name of one of the coalition participants. Coalition members can apply for up to \$1 million to address petroleum and/or hazardous substances. RI DEM plans to submit a proposal in this category and is looking for two or more coalition members to partner with the Department in this effort.
