From North of Providence:

I-95 South toward PROVIDENCE RI.

Take the US-6 W / RI-10 exit- EXIT 22C-B-A- toward DOWNTOWN / PROVIDENCE PLACE. 0.3 miles

Merge onto MEMORIAL BLVD via EXIT 22A on the LEFT toward DOWNTOWN. 0.8 miles

Turn RIGHT onto PINE ST. (Capriccio's Restaurant)<0.1 miles

The building is on the left above the restaurant McFadden's. New Commons is on the second floor.

From South of Providence:

I-95 North toward PROVIDENCE RI.

Merge onto I-195 E via EXIT 20 toward EAST PROVIDENCE / CAPE COD.

Take EXIT 1 toward DOWNTOWN PROVIDENCE. 0.2 miles

Go through a set of lights at Dyer past Friendship.

Turn LEFT onto PINE ST. <0.1 miles

The building is on the left above the restaurant McFadden's. New Commons is on the second floor.
