Request for Exemption to Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 4 - Open Fires For Burning Agricultural Material on Farms

Farms may apply for a permit from DEM for open burning of agricultural material, i.e. brush piles, for weed abatement or pest control and when no alternative practical method of disposal is available, in accordance with Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 4 - Open Fires. Burning by resident homeowners on property owned by them where there is no commercial, industrial or salvage activity does not require a state exemption.

To apply for a permit to burn agricultural material on farms:

- Request a site visit by DEM Division of Agriculture: (401) 222-2781, ext. 4516
- Contact fire chief of district for approval

Local ordinances must be adhered to for open burning. Issuance of burn permits could be restricted during some periods. Typically burn permits are issued November to March.
