RE: Release of Notice of Violation dated August 21, 2015
OC&I-HW-14-96

Dear Mr. Calcagni:

On August 21, 2015 RIDEM issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) to Bio Waste, LLC (Bio Waste) alleging certain violations of the Rules & Regulations for Hazardous Waste Management (the "Hazardous Waste Regulations"). In the NOV RIDEM cited Bio Waste for receiving hazardous waste from a company named Prescription Compounding Specialist of RI and transporting hazardous waste without first obtaining a permit and without completing a manifest. On September 16, 2015 representatives of Bio Waste met with RIDEM to discuss the NOV and asserted that the company had not transported hazardous waste as alleged in the NOV. Bio Waste further indicated that the company provides guidance material to all of its clients that specifically indicates Bio Waste is not authorized to receive and transport hazardous waste. Bio Waste representatives offered to provide copies of records to RIDEM to demonstrate that the company had not transported hazardous waste without a permit.

On September 16, 2015 RIDEM received an email from Angelo Calcagni containing several attachments including copies of medical waste tracking forms. On September 22, 2015 RIDEM received records from Prescription Compounding Specialists containing detailed inventories of the waste that was taken offsite by Bio Waste for disposal. Review of these records revealed that there is no evidence at this time to indicate that Bio Waste received and transported hazardous waste without a permit as alleged in the NOV. Consequently, RIDEM is hereby rescinding the Notice of Violation issued to Bio Waste on August 21, 2015.
