CONSENT AGREEMENT

A. INTENT & PURPOSE

This Agreement is entered by and between the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management's Office of Compliance & Inspection ("RIDEM") and Harris Industries, Inc. (the "Respondent"). This Agreement is entered in accordance with Section 42-17.1-2 et seq. of the Rhode Island General Laws ("R.I.G.L.") for the purpose of resolving the administrative enforcement action set forth in a Notice of Violation ("NOV") issued to the Respondent by RIDEM on December 31, 2010.

B. STIPULATED FACTS

- (1) WHEREAS, the subject property is located at 181 Conant Street, Pawtucket, Rhode Island (the "Property"). The Property includes a facility used for the manufacture of flexographic printing products (the "Facility").
- (2) WHEREAS, the Facility is operated by Harris Industries, Inc.
- (3) WHEREAS, the Respondent is registered with RIDEM as a small quantity hazardous waste generator pursuant to RIDEM's Rules and Regulations for Hazardous Waste Management (the "Hazardous Waste Regulations") and pursuant to Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations ("40 CFR") under the name of "Harris Industries Inc" with the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") hazardous waste generator identification number RIR000507632.
- (4) WHEREAS, on December 31, 2010, RIDEM issued a NOV to the Respondent alleging certain violations of the Hazardous Waste Regulations.
- (5) WHEREAS, the Respondent requested an administrative hearing to contest the NOV.
- (6) WHEREAS, the Respondent complied with the Order section of the NOV.

- (7) WHEREAS, in lieu of proceeding to an administrative adjudicatory hearing on the NOV and in order to effect a timely and amicable resolution of the NOV, RIDEM and the Respondent hereby agree that it is in the best interest of the parties and in the public interest to resolve the issues raised in the NOV.
- (8) WHEREAS, RIDEM finds that this Agreement is a reasonable and fair settlement and adequately protects the public interest in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Regulations.

C. AGREEMENT

- (1) JURISDICTION – RIDEM has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Agreement and has personal jurisdiction over the Respondent.
- (2) FORCE and EFFECT – This Agreement shall have the full force and effect of a final compliance order issued after a full hearing on the merits pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws Section 42-35-1 et seq. from which no timely appeal was taken, and which is enforceable in Superior Court in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws Section 42-17.1-2(21)(v).
- (3) APPLICATION – The provisions of this Agreement shall apply to and be binding upon RIDEM, the Respondent and its agents, servants, employees, successors, assigns and all persons, firms and corporations acting under, through and for the Respondent in the performance of work relating to or impacting the requirements of this Agreement.
- (4) PENALTY – Respondent shall pay to RIDEM the sum of Nine Thousand Sixty-Six Dollars (\$9,066.00) in administrative penalties as follows:
 - (a) Upon execution of this Agreement by the Respondent, the Respondent shall pay to RIDEM the sum of Nine Thousand Sixty-Six Dollars (\$9,066.00).
 - (b) Penalties that the Respondent agrees to pay in this Consent Agreement are penalties payable to and for the benefit of the State of Rhode Island and are not compensation for actual pecuniary loss.
 - (c) All penalty payments shall be in the form of a certified check, cashiers check, or money order, payable to the ***R.I. General Treasurer –Environmental Response Fund Account***. All payments shall be delivered to:

D. COMPLIANCE

- (1) EFFECT OF COMPLIANCE – Compliance with and fulfillment of this Agreement shall be deemed to resolve all issues raised in the NOV dated December 31, 2010.

- (2) COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS – Compliance with the terms of this Agreement does not relieve the Respondent of any obligation to comply with any other applicable laws or regulations administered by, through or for RIDEM or any other governmental entity.
- (3) ADDITIONAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS – Upon a determination by the Director that there is a threat to the public health or the environment, or upon discovery of any new information, RIDEM reserves the right to take additional enforcement actions as provided by law or regulation, including, but not limited to, the issuance of “Immediate Compliance Orders” as authorized by R.I.G.L. § 42-17.1-2(21). This Agreement shall not restrict any right to hearing or other right available by statute or regulation that the Respondent may have regarding any new enforcement action commenced by RIDEM after the execution of this Agreement.
- (4) FUTURE ACTIVITIES AND UNKNOWN CONDITIONS – This Agreement shall not operate to shield the Respondent from liability arising from future activities, as of the date of execution of this Agreement.
- (5) NOTICE AND COMMUNICATION - Communications regarding this Agreement shall be directed to:
