Pete:

I wanted to confirm that I received your message.

Thanks for running the wetlands issue by Chuck. I'm glad that's not an issue.

With respect to the tanks behind the former building N - I'm aware that there has been sort of a running battle regarding the existence these tanks for some time. So, I finally walked down to the tank program and pulled the log book based on your 1995 closure date. The log book gave me a file number (LS28109) for the Gorham site. In that file I found a Marcy 27, 1995 letter from ABB Environmental Services, Inc. regarding the investigation of two tanks, estimated at 15K gallons each, located behind Building N. According to this letter (see attached) the tanks were partially excavated and investigated for removal but were ultimately left in-place. So, unless you have different information, it looks like those 2 tanks are still there.

If the tanks are still there and they interfere with the new access road, then they may need to be removed before the road can go in. Otherwise, Gorham can wait until later to remove them, but either way the tanks will in all likelihood have to come out of the ground eventually.
