This email is to formally revise one comment on the document titled *Public Involvement Comments and Response to Hartford Park Resident's Association (HPRA) Comments Lincoln Lace and Braid Remediation Project* dated 22 April 2010, submitted to RIDEM by EA.

Comment 3 states the following: *R. McMahon stated that quarterly inspections to evaluate the integrity of the cap and condition of trees by the Parks Department will be incorporated into the ELUR.*

Further discussion on this point has led to the decision that quarterly inspections are excessive and semiannual inspections will suffice to maintain cap integrity. EA will include this requirement in the draft Environmental Land Usage Restriction that will be submitted with the Revised Remedial Action Work Plan upon receipt of the anticipated Remedial Decision Letter.
