Dear Medical Waste Generator:

We are writing to you regarding recent concerns about handling medical waste associated with the Covid-19 virus. Our Medical Waste Regulations require universal precautions to ensure that ALL medical waste be packaged in a manner that protects those who handle medical waste as well as the general public. We want to emphasize certain aspects of those requirements for generators that are particularly important at this time.

Generators are required to ensure the red bag waste is tied off or otherwise sealed prior to placing in the containers. Sharps containers must be sealed to prevent spillage of contents during transport.
