



Individual Tightness Tester License Application

2020 - 2021

Any individual who performs, or offers to perform, tightness testing on any underground storage tank (UST), product piping (primary and interstitial space), piping/STP sump, under-dispenser containment (UDC), or spill containment basin (SCB) (e.g., spill bucket) is required to be licensed by RI DEM. Licenses are issued on an annual basis and expire on September 30th of every year. There is an annual \$100 license fee per applicant which must be included with this application. It is the testers responsibility to submit their renewal application and fee prior to August 30th to ensure there is no break in their license. Failure to submit a renewal application by August 30th will result in a \$25 late fee. Any tightness test performed by an individual who is not licensed is considered invalid and will not be accepted. Submit this application, along with payment and applicable documentation to:

Please be aware that failure to follow these requirements, as well as failing to comply with any section of the UST Regulations, may result in your license being suspended or revoked!

Attach the following to your application:

- For primary wall UST and product piping test methods, a Certificate or valid documentation of training issued by the manufacturer or developer of each test method you wish to be licensed in. This must be submitted annually.
- For UST and product piping interstitial, and all sump, under-dispenser containment and spill containment basin tightness test methods, exam results or a certificate showing successful completion of the RI DEM tightness test Certification exam. - Annual Application License Fee of \$100.00 per individual in the form of a check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of Rhode Island, Water and Air Protection Fund".
- If the tester was licensed in the prior year but failed to renew their license, a late fee of \$25 must be included with this application
- A Certificate of Liability Insurance consistent with amounts and coverages as specified in Rule 1.16(D)(1)(c) of the UST Regulations

I certify under penalty of law that the information submitted in this application and all attached documents is true, accurate and complete. I understand that falsifying information, including submittal of false test results may result in revocation of your license and administrative, civil and/or criminal penalties.
