The Providence School Department affirms that the City of Providence intends to pay for outside environmental monitoring services for the life of the project. An RFP will be prepared and advertised for bid covering all DEM-required monitoring services. The initial bid period will be for five years. During this initial period payment will be made by the Providence Public Buildings Authority. Beyond that period payment will be made by the Providence School Department as Lessee.

If, for any reason, the Providence School Department does not pay for these services under the lease, the Providence Public Building Authority has the authority and will order and pay for the monitoring.
