Subject: Five Year Review of Springfield Street Schools

Dear Mr. Sepe, Mr. Maher and Ms. Pallister-

The Department is beginning the process of the Court ordered five year review of the Springfield Street Schools in Providence. As you can see from the two(2) attachments (August 2012 and November 2012), there were a number of items that were to be completed by the City of Providence during the past five years. The Department has recently determined that several of the items have not been addressed or reported quarterly to the Department for placement on the public web site. Two specific items, the finalization of the new draft ELUR (submitted to the City in November 2012) and submission of the recorded copy for placement on the web page. Also, the last quarterly monitoring report from the City consultant was received in March 2015 (for the September 2014 quarter). An email sent to the Department in December 2015 indicated that some soil gas wells at the site had been vandalized and that the City was moving to replace them. The Department has not received any written correspondence that this work completed.

Please respond as soon as possible and indicate what steps the City is going to perform to get into compliance.
