

GEOFLOW is an innovative alternative to traditional leach fields. It reduces or eliminates the need for "mound" systems in many applications, since it is installed just 12-18" below the surface. With over 200 installations throughout New England, GEOFLOW is a proven, highly efficient method to dispose of wastewater effluent.

Our Rhode Island DEM Class II approval gives us a two foot separation to groundwater, and a four foot separation to impervious layers. Combined with the shallow installation depth, the GEOFLOW Drip system can help preserve the natural land contours of existing sites. In many applications the drip tubing can be pulled into existing soils, so site disturbance is minimal. Please see the enclosed photographs for examples of some recent GEOFLOW installations. 


