The operator of a small MS4 that discharges to Special Resource Protection Waters (SRPWs), Outstanding National Resource Waters (ONRWs), or impaired waters, will be required to obtain a permit by March 2008, unless the operator has demonstrated effective protection of water quality to the satisfaction of the Director.

The operator of a small MS4 located partially within an urbanized area and has not been previously waived may expand the six minimum measure program throughout jurisdiction.
