


The Vineyards of Rhode Island




Directions

From Newport: Take Rte. 138 North. Just past the "Entering Portsmouth" sign turn right onto Braman's Lane. Go to the end, take a right onto Wapping Road and then a left onto our driveway. Proceed to the end.

From Fall River:

Take Rte. 24 South, cross the Sakonnet River, take Exit 1. Go under the highway and merge onto Rte. 138 South. Pass State Police Barracks, at next traffic light take a left onto Sandy Point Avenue, then take a right onto Wapping Road. Our driveway, Greenvale Lane, is 9/10 of a mile down on the left side. Proceed to the end.

Directions

From Newport: Drive East on Memorial Boulevard past Easton's Beach, then bear left (North) on Aquidneck Ave. (Rte. 138A) to East Main Road (Rte. 138). Bear right onto Rte. 138. Newport Vineyards & Winery is 3/4 mile North on the right (#909).

From Providence: Drive East on Rte. 195 to Rte. 24 South. Cross the Sakonnet River Bridge. Take Exit #1 (Rte. 138) and follow it South for 10 minutes. Winery is on the left (#909).

Sakonnet also produces specialty wines including Ice Wine, Port, and an award-winning Sparkling wine.


Directions
