- 2. <u>Lobster Fishery Conservation Management Area 2 (Inshore Southern New England)</u>
 - F. Mandatory V-Notching Requirements There are currently no mandatory V-notching requirements for any person or vessel permitted and declared to fish in LFMA 2.
 - F. Mandatory V-Notching Requirements Effective June 1, 2012, any person or vessel permitted or declared to fish in LCMA 2, shall be required to v-notch all egg bearing female lobsters and return them to the water immediately.
- 3. Lobster Fishery Conservation Management Area 3 (Offshore Waters) –
 A. Minimum Gauge Size The minimum gauge size for American lobster in LCMA 3 shall be no lower than 3-1/2 inches (88.90 mm) carapace length.

 However, effective January 1, 2013, Tthe minimum gauge size for American lobster in LCMA 3 shall be no lower than the carapace length identified in the following schedule. July 1st is the deadline for implementing these minimum gauge size increases. of 3-17/32 inches (89.69 mm).
