3.2.1-3 – Current Possession limit

Species	Current possession limit	Effective dates
Black Sea Bass	CLOSED <u>50 pounds per vessel per calendar day</u>	Effective 12:01 AM on September 2, November 2, 2011, until the next sub period begins on November 1, 2011, January 1, 2012 at 250 750 pounds per vessel per calendar day.
Menhaden	120,000 pounds per vessel per calendar day <u>CLOSED</u>	Effective 12:01 AM on October 14, 28, 2011, until further notice.
Scup – General Category	40,000 8,000 pounds per vessel per calendar week <u>day</u>	Effective 12:01 AM on October 16, November 2, 2011, until the next sub period begins on November 1, 2011 January 1, 2012, at 2,000 pounds per vessel per calendar day.
Scup – Floating Fish Traps	<u>8,000 pounds per fish trap licensee per calendar day</u>	<u>Effective 12:01 AM on November 2, 2011, until the next sub period begins on January 1, 2012.</u>
Striped Bass – Floating Fish Traps	<u>CLOSED</u>	<u>Effective 12:01 AM on October 28, 2011, until the next fishing season begins on January 1, 2012.</u>
Summer Flounder	1,000 600 pounds per vessel per calendar day <u>and the summer flounder aggregate landing program will end.</u> or 5,000 pounds per vessel per calendar week if the vessel is permitted for the summer flounder aggregate program. The fishery is closed for all commercial fishers on Friday and Saturday of each week.	Effective 12:01 AM on October 23, November 1, 2011, until the next sub period begins on November 1, 2011, January 1, 2012. at 600 pounds per vessel per calendar day.
