

3.2.1-3 – Current Possession limit – If no current possession limit is noted in the table below, refer to Part 7 of the RI Marine Fisheries Statutes and Regulations for the sub period starting possession limit for all species other than striped bass, menhaden, and horseshoe crabs. For striped bass, if no current possession limit is noted in the table below, refer to Part 12 of the RI Marine Fisheries Statutes and Regulations for the sub period starting possession limit. For horseshoe crabs, refer to Part 15 of the RI Marine Fisheries Statutes and Regulations. For menhaden, refer to Part 16 of the RI Marine Fisheries Statutes and Regulations.

Scup – General Category	CLOSED 25,000 pounds per vessel per calendar week	Effective 12:01 AM on October 17, <u>October 31,</u> 2010, until the next sub period begins on November 1, 2010 at 2,000 pounds per vessel per calendar day.
Scup – Floating Fish Traps	CLOSED 1,000 pounds per fish trap licensee per calendar day	Effective 12:01 AM on April 21, <u>October 31,</u> 2010, until the next sub period begins on <u>January 1, 2011.</u> May 1, 2010, with an unlimited possession limit per fish trap licensee.
