

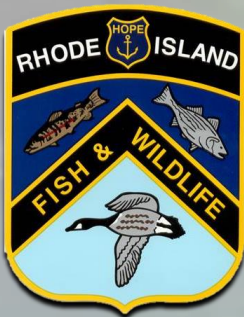
RI Hunter Education Program announces a free course  
in  
**LAND NAVIGATION**

**In this 16 hour course students will utilize map, protractor, and compass to learn:**

- **Map reading**
- **Terrain association**
- **Point to point navigation**
- **Pace counting**
- **Techniques on how to navigate unpopulated areas**
- **Other land navigation topics**



**Course Description:** This two day informational (non-certification) course will consist of a ½ day classroom introduction to land navigation and map, protractor, and compass work with the remainder held outdoors performing practical exercises. This course will include active participation by course attendees in an outdoor, woodlands setting. Please dress according to the most current weather forecast as well as bring 200 square inches of solid fluorescent orange clothing (hat). Attendees should be in sufficient physical shape to walk in wooded areas and climb over/around typically encountered woodland obstacles. Maps will be provided however attendees are strongly encouraged to bring and use their own orienteering compasses (a small number of compasses will be available).

This workshop is offered free of charge but pre-registration is required.
