DEM Launched New

RI Shellfish Harvester Education & Certification Program

January 2022

Dear Applicant:

DEM launched a new education and certification program in 2018 that is mandatory for everyone who commercially harvests and lands shellfish in RI. The goal of the program is to ensure that shellfish harvesters deliver a safe product to shellfish dealers and, in turn, to shellfish consumers. **This course must be completed prior to the issuance of a new license/endorsement.**

In accordance with US FDA requirements, and new regulations adopted by DEM in 2018, holders of all applicable commercial licenses and landing permits must obtain certification via the new program. Applicants must submit Certificate of Completion prior to license issuance (new applicants only).

The certification requirement applies to:

- All holders of commercial shellfish licenses -- i.e., Principal Efforts Licenses and Commercial
 Fishing Licenses with quahog, soft-shell clam, and/or shellfish other endorsements; Over 65
 Shellfish Licenses, and Student Shellfish Licenses;
- All holders of Multipurpose Licenses who harvest shellfish; and
- All holders of landing permits who land shellfish.

The certification requirement applies to both license/permit renewals and new licenses/permits, beginning in 2018. All certificates are valid for 5 years, after which re-certification will be required.
