This matter came before Hearing Officer McMahon for a Prehearing Conference on December 3, 1993. Respondent failed to comply with the Prehearing Order and also failed to appear or otherwise apprise the Hearing Officer of his inability to appear at said Prehearing Conference. On December 8, 1993, this Hearing Officer issued a Conditional Order of Default affording the Respondent until December 15, 1993, to show good cause why a Final Order of Default should not enter and the Notice of Violation become a Compliance Order. The Respondent has failed to respond to the Conditional Order and has not shown good cause why the Conditional Order of Default should be vacated. Wherefore, it is hereby

ORDERED

1. That Respondent is deemed to have waived his right to an adjudicatory hearing and the Notice of Violation shall be final and become a Compliance Order immediately upon the entry of the Final Order herein.
