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

Food Waste Baseline: Rhode Island

- 100,300 tons of food waste being disposed of at the RI Central Landfill in 2015
 - 61% RI homes and 31% commercial sector
- 50% reduction = 50,150 tons
- EPA Excess Food Generators Data/Mapping
- Food Recovery Opportunities Map
