### I. CALL TO ORDER:

A regular meeting of the Derelict and Abandoned Vessel and Obstruction Removal Commission was called to order at approximately 9:00am on Thursday, January 23, 2020 at the RIDEM, Division of Law Enforcement, Wickford Marine Base, 150 Fowler St., No. Kingstown, RI. Kurt Blanchard, Chair presided over the meeting. A quorum was present that included the abovelisted members.

### II. OLD BUSINESS:

## 1. Proposed Meeting Minutes Review and Vote:

Commissioners reviewed and approved draft meeting minutes from the Tuesday, September 24, 2019 meeting. The Chair entertained a MOTION to accept the minutes; Commissioner Dan Goulet moved to APPROVED the meeting minutes, Commissioner Tim Mills SECONDED the MOTION. Vote was UNANIMOUS, 4-0 in favor.

# 2. Application Review:

Commissioners reviewed an application submitted by the town of Little Compton involving an abandoned sailing vessel that ran aground on the sea wall located in Breakwater Pt., Little Compton. The Chair advised the vessel ran aground on May 20, 2019 and was considered for the Commission's November application period. The cost to the town to remove the vessel was \$1,500. Commissioners then completed the scoring form to evaluate the application.

Commissioner Prescott made the MOTION to move forward with the Demand Letter, Commissioner Mills SECONDED the MOTION. Vote was UNANIMOUS. <u>4-0 in favor</u>.
